Information for Accepted Entries for the 2021 GWS Member Exhibition.
Please follow all the instructions carefully.

The Georgia Watercolor Society now requires that all accepted artists sign a Disclaimer Form and return it before **July 19, 2021** to Member Show co-chair Mary Ann Cox (see Form II below).

This ensures that all paintings juried into the show conform to the same high standards. No entry will be hung without a completed Disclaimer Form. The Exhibition Committee reserves the right to remove any painting that does not comply with these requirements. The Disclaimer Form can be found on page 5 at the end of this document.

Please use the checklist below to ensure that your painting conforms to the standards set out in the prospectus and disclaimer form. You do not need to return the checklist; it is for your convenience only. Only a copy of the Disclaimer Form needs to be returned.

Artwork Requirements:

_____ My accepted painting is not a rendering or likeness of another artist's work and is my original work from conception through execution.

_____ It was created without class or teacher supervision.

_____ It is original work using watermedia. Watercolor, acrylic, casein, gouache, and egg tempera are all allowed. **Pastels, charcoal, alcohol ink and Oil, including water-soluble oil, are not allowed.** Mixed media and collage are acceptable but only if all elements are made using watermedia created by the artist.

_____ The painting is not a preprinted or computer-generated image.

_____ It was created on paper, Yupo, watercolor canvas, canvas or Claybord. Rice paper and Tyvek is permissible.

_____ It was completed within the last two years.

_____ It was not previously exhibited in any GWS show.

Presentation:

_____ The painting is framed in wood or metal in either gold, silver, black, brown, or natural wood tones.

_____ The frame is plain and unadorned and does not exceed 3” in width. It is ready for hanging with wire in place.

_____ Plexiglass is used – NO GLASS.

or

The work may be varnished or waxed before framing. (These paintings do not require plexiglass).

_____ The maximum frame size does not exceed 48” in either direction.

_____ The image size displayed within the mat is not smaller than 8” x 10.”

_____ Mats and liners, if any, are white or variations of white (e.g. cream or off-white).

Airfloat, Masterpack or comparable foam lined boxes are strongly recommended. You can call Airfloat at 800-445-2580 and ask for the GWS member discount. Proper packaging is imperative to protect your work. Improper packaging may result in damaged, returned or unopened shipments. There is a handling fee of \$25.00 for artists who do not use these boxes.

_____ I have packed my artwork in a commercial foam lined art box as above.

or

_____ I have included a check for \$25.00 to Georgia Watercolor Society for the handling fee and have attached the check to the wire hanger on the back of the painting.

_____ I attached a photo of the painting inside the box so that it is visible when repacking. This will help ensure that the correct painting is returned.

_____ I did not use a wood or metal crate.

_____ I did not pack with popcorn or similar filling. Such packages will be returned and your painting will not be included in the exhibition.

_____ I shipped my painting to arrive at the center between July 21 – 23.

_____ A prepaid return shipping label was enclosed.

Hand-delivered Artwork:

Hand-delivered paintings must arrive at Bowen Center for the Arts,
334 Hwy. 9 N., Dawsonville, GA 30534 on July 24, between 10:00 am and 1:00 pm.

Judging

Final judging will be from the actual artwork, not the digital image, with juror's right of refusal. Artists may not substitute another work for an accepted work, nor change sales price or withdraw work once it has been accepted. Any painting that does not comply with the prospectus guidelines will be disqualified. Any artist whose painting is disqualified will not be allowed to enter any GWS show for 1 year.

Liability and Insurance

Although the utmost care will be taken in handling paintings, the Georgia Watercolor Society, GWS representatives, and the Bowen Center will not be responsible for damage or loss, whatever the cause. Artists are encouraged to carry their own insurance.

Forms

Please fill out the attached forms. Please tape the identifying form, Form I, to the back of your painting making sure you have signed it. If you are shipping your art, place your prepaid return shipping label **into** an envelope and attach the envelope to the wire hanger on the back of your painting. Fill out and sign the disclaimer form, Form II, and return to Mary Ann Cox before July 19, 2021.
